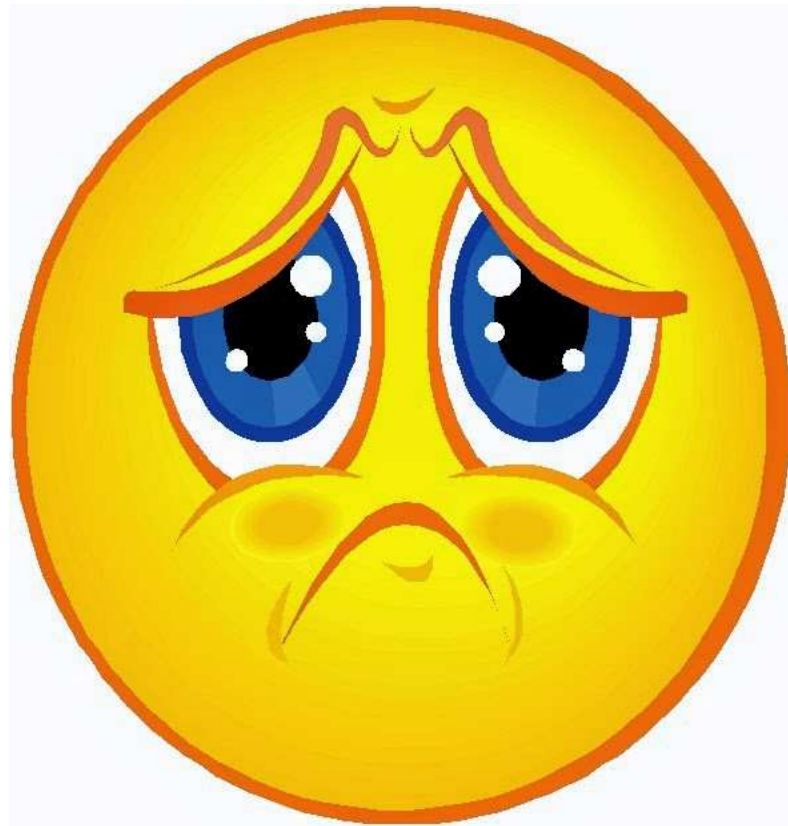
MOZART

DIED IN 1791 IN VIENNA, AUSTRIA

severe fever so he died at the
age of 37*
